The small site offers pitches for caravans, tents and campervans and has spectacular coastal and rural views from its elevated position.


Facilities include electric hook-ups, free showers and toilets, laundry equipment, dish washing and ice pack facilities.

M5 to Exeter

Bear left on the B3287 to Tregony. From Tregony follow the signs for St Mawes for 7 miles to Trewithian. Turn left at the sign for Gerrans, Portscatho, Trewince Manor etc. Stay on this road, following signs for St Anthony, to Trewince Farm one mile beyond Gerrans village.
